

Monitoring

Teams trained in election codes, voting machine security protocols, and federal civil rights law will monitor polling sites and county election centers all through election day, reporting violations via live communications networks and in collaboration with legal incident intervention attorneys.

Exit Polling

Until handcount sample audits are instituted, independent exit polls are our best check on the validity of officially reported election results.

Selected House, Senate, and statewide office contests will be tracked by professional exit polls commissioned by the citizens. Polling data will be combined with other metrics by EDA Data Analysis to sound alarm if patterns indicate fraud. Needed: \$400,000 in donations large and small.

Communications

Broadcast quality video and audio teams will rove polls during day and convene at county vote centers by close of polls. Their coverage will be augmented by wireless web correspondents using cell phones enabled with text, photo, audio and video capabilities, uploading live coverage to net.channels. Live two-way exchange between field correspondents and EDA Data Analysis and Publicity.

Legal

Volunteer attorneys prepared with writs of mandamus and temporary restraining orders obtained in advance, on the basis of documented prior violations, will monitor selected election jurisdictions for compliance with all laws concerning citizen rights of observation, public records requests, voting system use procedures and election security protocols. Data Analysis

In selected contests, EDA will assemble baseline sets of past voting data, opinion polls, and exit polls, and compare this data with incoming election results, in real-time computerized data analysis utilizing multiple methods of statistical and pattern analysis. EDA is developing data-sharing formats and a database interface to enable rapid processing and reporting of election anomalies, to be instantly communicated to general public via wireless web network and internet radio.

Demonstrations

Assemble at county election centers before close of polls and maintain a vigil throughout election night with banners, signs, slogans and songs. Press releases addressing election day incident reports and suspect patterns detected in election returns as reported by EDA Data Analysis. Live video, radio, and text uplinks from election centers to EDRR web and radio network.
